Dear Patients,

Due to the Coronavirus, we have had to make some temporary changes to the way we serve you.

Our doors will be closed, but we will still provide your free medications and medical appointments.

- At your scheduled appointment time, our doctors will call you.
- **PLEASE MAKE SURE WE HAVE YOUR CORRECT PHONE NUMBER.**
- When you are ready to pick up your medication, please call us once you arrive in our parking lot. We will bring your medicine to your car.
- Please do not come to the door. Our doors will be locked and we are not able to open them to anyone.
- You will be able to reach us by phone during our normal hours of operation, Monday through Thursday.
- During this time, we are not able to offer labs, chiropractic care, or physical therapy.

This is our only option to keep you and our staff safe.
